

1 解答 (1) 8 (2) 2 (3) $4\sqrt{3}$

$$\begin{aligned}(1) \quad & 8 \div 4 + 6 \\ & = 2 + 6 \\ & = 8\end{aligned}$$

$$\begin{aligned}(2) \quad & \frac{1}{2} + \frac{9}{10} \times \frac{5}{3} \\ & = \frac{1}{2} + \frac{3}{2} \\ & = 2\end{aligned}$$

$$\begin{aligned}(3) \quad & 2\sqrt{3} + \sqrt{27} - \frac{3}{\sqrt{3}} \\ & = 2\sqrt{3} + 3\sqrt{3} - \sqrt{3} \\ & = 4\sqrt{3}\end{aligned}$$
